The first 18 are recommended for their low water, drought tolerant qualities. Each is considered to be “evergreen”.

Botanical Name: *Fallugia paradoxa*
Mature Height X Width: 5-6' X 4-6'
Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 0 degrees
Comments: Native to Arizona

Common Name: Baja Fairyduster
Botanical Name: *Calliandra californica*
Mature Height X Width: 4-5' X 4-5'
Sun Requirements: Full Sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 25 degrees
Comments: Attracts humming birds

Common Name: Black Dalea
Botanical Name: *Dalea frutescens*

Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade
Water Requirements: Low to Moderate
Drought Tolerant: No
Hardy to: 25 degrees
Comments: Attracts hummingbirds, bright spring growth turns green, semi deciduous

Common Name: Turpentine Bush
Botanical Name: *Ericameria laricifolia*
Mature Height X Width: 3-4' X 3-4'
Sun Requirements: Full Sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 5 degrees
Comments: Native to Arizona, blooms in late fall

Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade

Comments: Attracts hummingbirds

Common Name: Green Feathery Cassia

Comments: Fast growing, attracts bees.

Hardy to: 20 degrees
Comments: Moderate to fast growing, yellow daily like flower throughout the fall and winter months.

Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 28 degrees
Comments: Small purple / lavender bell shaped flower

Botanical Name: *Leucohyllus species*
Mature Height X Width: 3-8' X 4-8'
Sun Requirements: Full sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 10 - 18 degrees depending on type
Comments: Varieties include "Green Cloud", "Silver Cloud", "White Cloud" and "Thunder Cloud"

Common Name: Woolly Butterfly Bush
Botanical Name: *Buddleia marrubifolia*
Mature Height X Width: 3-5' X 3-5'
Sun Requirements: Full sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 15 degrees
Comments: Attracts butterfly's, nearly constant orange bloom

Common Name: Jojoba
Botanical Name : *Simmondsia chinensis*
Mature Height X Width: 6-10' X 6-8'
Sun Requirements: Full sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 15 degrees
Comments: Native to Arizona, Female plant produces fruit (nut), inconspicuous flower

Common Name: Chuparosa
Botanical Name: *Justicia californica*
Mature Height X Width: 3' X 4'
Sun Requirements: Full Sun
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 25 degrees
Comments: Moderate to fast growing, attracts hummingbirds

Common Name: Yellow Bells
Botanical Name: *Tecoma stans*
Mature Height X Width: 4-25' X 3-15'
Sun Requirements: Full sun to partial shade
Water Requirements: Low
Drought Tolerant: Yes
Hardy to: 28 degrees (root hardy to 20)
Comments: Native to Arizona, attracts hummingbirds, trumpet shaped yellow flower

Common Name: Grevillea
Botanical Name: *Noellii*
Mature Height X Width: 3-6' X 6-8'
Sun Requirements: Full sun
Water Requirements: Low - moderate
Drought Tolerant:
Hardy to: 22 degrees
Comments: Pink and white flowers appear in spring
